### Coaches...

A number of vacancies exist due to the unavailability of some of last year's coaches. Anyone who is interested in coaching is encouraged to register his or her interest with our Junior Coordinator, Paul Bond.

Coaching courses are available (Hockey SA Level 1, Australian Sports Commission – general course which is a prequalification for the Active After School Care Program. Benefits include;

- Fees waived for players (or family members)
- Contributing to the development of junior players, which are the future of our club
- Expanding your own skills
- Preparation for coaching a senior team
- Free police check (mandatory for all coaches and managers) – useful if you get involved in other activities such as Active After School programs, SAPSASA

### School Program...

The Club is very keen to establish a program to be run at one or more primary schools in our area. In order to make this work, we need a coordinator to contact a range of schools to get their agreement to participate. Then, we need enough coaches to run clinics to teach basic skills followed by some games towards the end of term.

## FEES & PAYMENT for 2007...

### Fees in general

- Fees have been increased by an average of 5.3%. The increase in the fees reflects the increase in the Team Fee (including insurance) levied by the Association, which have increased by 14%.

### Discount

- A discount is available to Members who pay their fees in full by 31 May 2007.

### Credit card surcharge

- Any payment by credit card will attract a credit card surcharge of 3.0% up to a maximum of \$10 per transaction.

### Concessional

- This is for senior (ie over 17) players whose main income source is through government benefits or for full time students (including those over 21).

### Social team

- This is a team nominated in the lowest grade. For the 2007 season, this is Division 5 women and Division 7 men.

### Transitional team

- This is designed to allow for junior players, usually U17, to also play senior on a full time basis. This fee covers the fee for both seniors and juniors and is designed to encourage juniors to commence their senior careers. The allocation to a senior team will be based on ability.

### Junior fees

- Fees relate to the team in which the person is playing, not the actual age of the player. Eg an U15 playing U17 will pay the U17 fee.

### Second team

- The cost for playing in a second team is set only to recover the Team Fee levied by the Association.
- The second team fee will only apply for juniors who also play in a senior grade, juniors who play in two junior grades and seniors who also play in the veteran's grade.
- For juniors, the first fee is for their age group, with the second fee being for the second team (i.e. an older age group or seniors). The junior's second fee may be subject to a further concession through the transitional squad programme. For seniors playing veterans, the first fee is the senior fee, with the second fee being the Veteran's fee.
- The second team fee will only apply where the player is a permanent member of the second team. Casual 'fill-ins' would not need to pay an additional fee.

### Part time players

- For Members who only play on a part time basis, a Club Membership fee and a 'per game fee' is payable.
- The basis of the calculation is that a full season is played once a player plays more than 75% of the minor round games. For seniors there are 18 minor round games, therefore a full season is 13 games or more; for juniors there are 14 minor round games, making a full season 10 games or more.

### Family package

In recognition of the family nature of the game and to reduce the cost to families a family discount will apply:

- First fee: The most expensive fee – No discount
- Second fee: The next most expensive fee – 20% discount
- Third and subsequent fee: The remainder, in total - 30% discount
- Discounts do not apply to second team fees.
