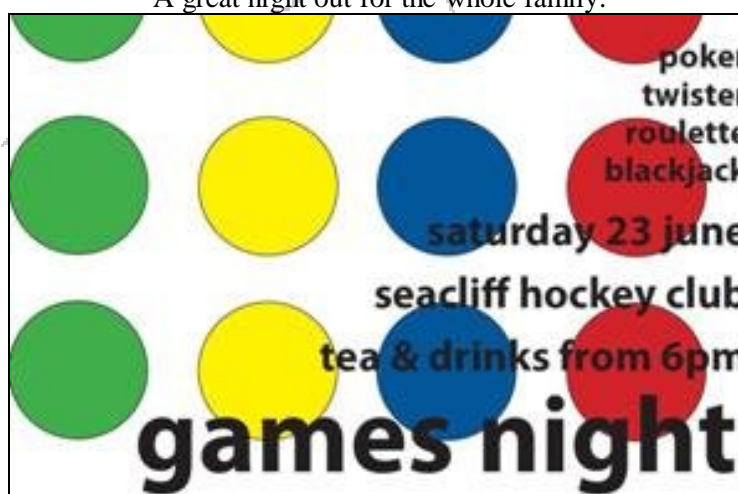

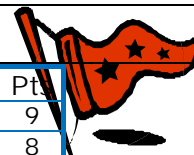

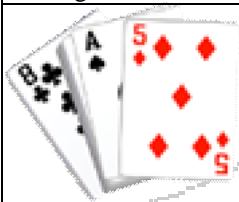

Sports Club Up-date...

The City of Holdfast Bay Council is currently looking into repairs of the downstairs changerooms. The extent of this work, and timing is yet to be decided, but removal of the cladding (walls) in both change rooms and to repair the shower alcoves is envisaged at this time. The repairs are most likely to occur during the summer months.

The Council has also provided the Sports Club with a much needed donation of \$20,000. This money is being returned to the 'Sinking Fund' for the next pitch replacement in some 15-20 years.
