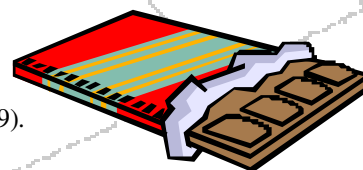

STATE JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS June 10 – 12



This carnival provides an opportunity for players to be selected in pathways squads as a part of the process of selecting state representative teams, it also provides a fantastic opportunity for the less experienced players to “Fast Track” the learning process by playing 7 or 8 games over 2 days. So, regardless of ability, it is strongly recommended that all players take part in the carnival. Teams will play all of their matches (except finals) at a nominated ground. This year, The Pines, Port, Woodville, North East, Grange and Adelaide will be used.

As in past years, it is intended that Seacliff will join forces with South Coast and nominate composite teams. This gives us a bit of extra cover for players who may have other commitments that cause them to miss a match.

There is a mixed Under 11 competition, with Boys and Girls U13, U15 and U18 competitions.

PLEASE NOTE; UNDER 18, NOT 17 FOR THESE CHAMPIONSHIPS.

There are finals in all grades EXCEPT Under 11.

Nominations close at Hockey SA on Friday 26th May, so please see your team manager or coach as soon as possible so we can confirm team nominations.

This major event is the beginning of the selection process for Hockey SA junior representative U13, U14, U15, U16, and U18 Girls and Boys teams.

Playing in the SJC will automatically nominate players for selection in their relevant age group (pathways squads). Once players have been selected from the SJC, they will then go into a pathways squad which will eventually narrow itself down into the final state team for each age group mentioned above.

JUNIOR HANDBOOK

Hockey SA has published a handbook for juniors; with an emphasis on helping new players (and their parents!) understand the sport and what is required of them. These will be available through team managers.
