## President Report...

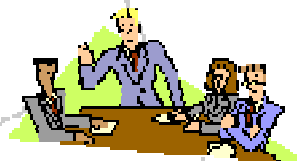

Are you a past player who no longer needs their club shirt?

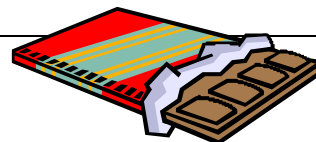
