### Umpiring 2010

#### New requirements

- Require all umpires to wear an approved "coloured shirt".
- Require all umpires that umpire senior and junior games to hold the minimum qualification of Community Umpire.
- A penalty of \$50 per game be applied where a Club supplies an umpire that is not qualified or suitably attired.
- In order to prevent ongoing non compliance the penalties shall be increased based on the number of teams a Club fields In the competition:
- Where a Club exceeds 2 breaches per team, in any season, then subsequent penalties shall be at the rate of \$100 per breach.
- Where a Club exceeds 3 breaches per team, in any season, then each team in the Club shall be deducted 3 premiership points.
